INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

1. Applicant should complete the enrolment form clearly and correctly.
2. The completed enrolment form should be submitted to the PEAK Examination Centre on or before the deadline for enrolment. Late submission will **NOT** be accepted.
3. **Enrolment Methods and Deadline for Enrolment** –

Enrolment Methods	Deadline for Enrolment
(a) Enrolment by post	3 weeks before the date of examination
(b) Enrolment in person or by a representative	2 weeks before the date of examination
4. Incomplete forms, forms without applicants' signature and forms received without payment will not be processed.
5. **Examination Fee** – HK\$700 for each examination paper.
6. Once the enrolment is accepted, any requests for re-scheduling and/or cancellation will not be entertained. Fees paid are not refundable or transferrable.
7. **Examination Results** – The examination notifications of result(s) will be sent to candidates in **15 full working days** after the examination.
8. **Certificates** - Candidates who have passed both Paper 1 and 2 of the Leveraged Foreign Exchange Trader's Representative Examination or both Paper 1 and 2 of the Leveraged Foreign Exchange Trader's Responsible Officer Examination within three years will be awarded certificates.
9. Candidates must notify the PEAK Examination Centre any change of address and personal particulars in writing in good time.

NOTES ON PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION

In view of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance which came into force on 20 December 1996, these Notes are prepared to assist you in understanding your rights and obligations in relation to the supply of personal data by you to the Vocational Training Council ("VTC"), which holds the examination(s) that you intend to sit for and the manner in which VTC may use or deal with such data in connection with the Leveraged Foreign Exchange Trading Examination and other relevant matters. VTC may transfer or provide the personal data and any examination-related information (e.g. examination result and information on the candidate's conduct and behaviour while taking the examination) of those candidates who have enrolled for the Leveraged Foreign Exchange Trading Examination to the Securities and Futures Commission ("SFC"). The personal data and examination-related information so transferred or provided may be used by the SFC for monitoring, verifying and matching (including "matching procedure" as defined in s.2 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, Cap 486) purposes as well as any other related purposes of assisting them to perform and discharge their functions.

You are entitled under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance to request access to or to request the correction of any data supplied by you, in the manner and subject to the limitations prescribed therein.
