

Professional Diploma in Business Management (PDBM)

Objectives:

This programme offers a flexible part-time learning route to students who are working in, or intending to enter into financial, marketing and other business services industries. The programme enables the students to acquire both theoretical and practical knowledge in the business management topics in order to:

- enhance their professional and academic knowledge;
- advance to bachelor degree programmes; and
- achieve life-long learning.

Features:

- Education for All: mature candidates, aged 23 or above with at least 2 years' relevant full-time working experience are welcome to apply
- **Provides Pathway to Honours Bachelor Degree:** graduates are eligible to enter the final year of the Bachelor of Business Administration (Hons)* co-offered by Coventry University and SHAPE
- Part-time Evening Delivery: modules delivered after office hours
- Flexible Modular Structure: 8 modules of 30 lecture hours each. Students are free to choose the modules taken each intake
- **Modules Exemption:** candidates with relevant academic background or professional qualification are eligible to apply for a maximum of 4 modules exemption
- Comprehensive Delivery: all classes are taught by well-experienced practicing professionals

*All candidates must be able to demonstrate competence in English Language equivalent to an HKCEE pass in English

Language (Grade E) or Level 2 in HKDSE English Language and have 3 years of relevant full-time working experience and complete certain elective module in the program.

Admission Requirements:

- Five HKDSE subjects at Level 2 or above, including English Language and Chinese Language with 2 or more years' relevant full-time working experience; OR
- Five HKCEE subjects at Grade E / Level 2 or above, including English Language# and Chinese Language with 3 or more years' relevant full-time working experience; OR
- Equivalent; OR
- Mature applicants i.e., those aged 23 or above, with 2 or more years of relevant full-time working experience, may also be accepted subject to a satisfactory admission interview.

#HKCEE English Language taken in 2006 or before should be at Grade E or above (Syllabus B) / Grade C or above (Syllabus A)

Mode of Study:

- (1) Face-to-face tutorial 30 hours
- (2) Examination 3 hours 10 sessions for each module, 3 hours per session, total 30 hours at weekday evening or weekend afternoon.

Programme Assessment:

- (1) Two assignments (20% each)* 40 % of total grade
- (2) A 3-hour final examination# 60 % of total grade
- To be eligible to sit for the final examination, students are required to attend at least 70% of the face-to-face tutorials and be required to retake the module if his/her attendance rate is below 70%.
- The overall passing mark (assignments + final examination) of each module is 40%. Students are required to get at least 40% on both assignments and final examination in order to pass a module.
- Satisfactory completion of the programme requires the completion of all modules within 4 years.
- Students who have successfully completed all of the required modules will be awarded the Professional Diploma in Business Management.
- * Quizzes, instead of assignments, for PBA40006 Business Statistics module in week 6 and 9
- One assignment weighted 30% and oral test in week 10 weighted 20% for PBA40007 Contemporary Business Communication module
- # A 2-hour final examination weighted 50% for PBA40007 Contemporary Business Communication module

- 2. Put all documents to be submitted in an envelope marked "Application for PDBM".
- 3. We need these documents from you:
 - · Completed enrollment form;
 - · Reference letter issued by your current employer; and
 - Copies of proof of your academic qualifications, such as transcripts and certificates.
- 4. Incomplete documents or lack of proof of payment required may delay or jeopardise your application.
- 5. Following a successful application, present the original copies of your credentials for verification at the time of registration.
- 6. We offer places to eligible applicants on a first-come-first-served basis.

Please pay course fees by either of these methods:

- 1. Attach a crossed cheque made payable to "Vocational Training Council" to the form submitted by post or in person
- 2. Pay by credit card, with submission of documents by fax / by post / in person
- 3. Pay in cash or by credit card to the General Office for a confirmed class that commences in 7 working days.
- Application period: lasts until it is 7 working days prior to scheduled class commencement.
